FLOOD ZONE DEVELOPMENT PERMIT

1. AUTHORITY:

A Flood Zone Development Permit shall be obtained before construction or development begins within any area of special Flood hazard established in Section 15.16.050B of the Rocklin Municipal Code (Section 15.16.060; Rocklin Municipal Code)

7. SUBMITTALS/INFORMATION REQUIRED: (attach to this form)

- A. Two sets of Improvement Plans drawn to scale
 - Show location, dimensions, and elevations of the area in question;
 - Show existing and proposed structures, fill, storage of materials, fencing, and drainage facilities, and clearly delineate the FEMA 100-year flood plain;
 - Mapping shall be at a minimum scale of one inch equals one hundred feet with a two-foot contour interval or better. Smaller projects may require a larger scale.
- **B.** Plans must show proposed elevation in relation to mean sea level of the lowest floor (including basement) of all structures.
- **C.** Description of extent to which any watercourse will be altered or relocated as a result of the proposed development.
- **D.** Description of the change in the one-hundred-year water surface elevation upstream and downstream of the project that would result from the project. Note: if the 100-year flood plain is impacted, the preparation of a backwater analysis is required.
- 8. THE CITY ENGINEER IS APPOINTED TO ADMINISTER AND IMPLEMENT THE REQUIREMENTS OF CHAPTER 15.16, ROCKLIN MUNICIPAL CODE. THE CITY ENGINEER SHALL COMPLETE A REVIEW OF THE FLOOD ZONE DEVELOPMENT PERMIT APPLICATION WITHIN THIRTY DAYS OF THE APPLICATION SUBMITTAL.
