## PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the **PLANNING COMMISSION** of the City of Rocklin will hold a public hearing in the **COUNCIL CHAMBERS** at the Rocklin City Hall, 3970 Rocklin Road, beginning at **6:30 p.m.** on **TUESDAY, AUGUST 17, 2021** to consider the following:

This application is a request for approval of a Design Review to allow the construction of a new company headquarters comprised of a main office (6,576 square feet), a maintenance building (4,800 square feet with mezzanine of 870 square feet), a sealer tank building (3,200 square feet), including truck and equipment storage and parking, employee and visitor parking, and associated site improvements, landscaping and appropriate hardscape. (Square footages are approximate.)

The subject site is located at 3998 Delmar Avenue. APNs 045-011-015 and -016.

The property is zoned Planned Development Light Industrial (PD-LI). The General Plan designation is Light Industrial (LI).

Notice is hereby given that the City of Rocklin will consider adoption of a Mitigated Negative Declaration for the development project described above. The review period for the Mitigated Negative Declaration begins on July 16, 2021 and ends at 5:00 p.m. August 5, 2021.
