The Rocklin Police Department recently obtained reaccreditation with the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies. Accreditation with CALEA voluntarily demonstrates the Rocklin Police Department's commitment to excellence in law enforcement through comprehensive written directives, professional standards, and best-practices.

Chief Chad Butler, Mayor Scott Yuill, Accreditation Manager Captain Forrest Richardson and Lt. Bart Paduveris accepted the reaccreditation from CALEA at a conference attended by more than 500 representatives from public safety agencies throughout North America.

"The Rocklin Police Department works diligently to maintain the highest standards and provide the best possible service to our community," Chief Butler said. "It is an honor to have the professionalism of the men and woman of our department recognized by CALEA."

According to CALEA, accreditation requires an agency to develop a comprehensive, uniform set of written directives. Accreditation standards also require reports and analyses necessary for leadership to make fact-based, informed management decisions.

CALEA accreditation strengthens an agency's accountability, both within the agency and the community, through a continuum of standards that clearly define authority, performance, and responsibilities.
