

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-187

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF ROCKLIN ESTABLISHING A PERMIT PARKING PROGRAM ON ABILENE  
CIRCLE AND STAGELINE CIRCLE

The City Council of the City of Rocklin does resolve as follows:

WHEREAS, the City of Rocklin Public Services Department and the City of Rocklin Police Department have investigated and verified that a parking issue exists on Abilene Circle, and that parking issue will potentially expand onto Stageline Circle; and

WHEREAS, the parking issue is a result of Whitney High School students parking on residential streets across from the campus creating a lack of available parking for residents and their guests; and

WHEREAS, the majority of residents surveyed on Abilene Circle support the establishment of a "Permit Parking Program" area; and

WHEREAS, the City of Rocklin Traffic Committee recommends creating a "Permit Parking Program" for residents on Abilene Circle and Stageline Circle; and

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 22507(a) allows local authorities to establish by ordinance or resolution a designation of certain streets upon which preferential parking privileges are given to residents; and Rocklin Municipal Code Section 10.08.040 authorizes the City Council to review reports prepared by the Traffic Committee and to adopt by resolution controls or zones describing the street(s) to be affected and the type of regulation needed to address the issue; and RMC Section 10.08.050 authorizes the City Council to establish time limits for parking vehicles upon certain streets between designated hours of any day, and to erect appropriate signs; and RMC Chapter 10.26 authorized the establishment of Permit Parking Programs in Rocklin in 2010; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Rocklin authorizes the establishment of a "Permit Parking Program" on Abilene Circle and Stageline Circle, as set forth in the attached Exhibit A, and directs the Chief of Police to establish necessary program administration, operating, and enforcement procedures.

## EXHIBIT A

Section 10.08.040 of the Rocklin Municipal Code specifies that a Parking Permit program be established by resolution and shall include the following provisions:

A. Describe the street, alley, public way or parking facility, or portion thereof to be affected, by its official name or such other description or designation as will, in the opinion of the traffic engineer, properly describe and give notice thereof;

This Parking Permit program shall include Abilene Circle and Stageline Circle.

B. Phased Implementation of the Parking Permit Program

As of the date of the initial approval of this Parking Permit program, the Parking Permit program shall be implemented only on Abilene Circle. This Parking Permit program shall not be implemented on Stageline Circle until such time that a parking issue has been observed and a majority of the households on Stageline Circle have expressed a clear desire to participate in the parking permit program.

C. Describe the regulation or control;

1. Official traffic control signs will be erected by the City of Rocklin Public Services Department notifying motorists of the permit parking areas.
2. The hours of parking restriction will be determined by the Traffic Engineer.
3. Parking permits will be issued and made available through the City of Rocklin Police Department. Parking permits must be clearly displayed on the dashboard or windshield of vehicles parked on the public streets within the designated permit parking areas. Vehicles not displaying the proper permit will be subject to citation for violation of section 10.24.080 of the Rocklin Municipal Code. The current fine for violating this section is \$55.00.

D. Describe the manner in which the vehicular traffic will be controlled; describe the type of signs, notices, markings, or other devices to be erected or installed;

The traffic will be controlled by signage erected on Abilene Circle and if the program is extended, then on Stageline Circle. The signs will contain verbiage similar to:

PARKING BY PERMIT ONLY  
Monday - Friday  
8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.  
Violators will be cited per RMC 10.24.080

E. Shall contain such other pertinent information as will properly give notice of the purpose and intent to be accomplished by the regulations.

- Each residence shall be issued four (4) parking permits for their use by the Rocklin Police Department at no charge. The permits shall be valid for a period of two (2) years. These permits may be used by any vehicle with permission of the residents to provide for family or guest parking.
- Additional permits may be obtained through the Rocklin Police Department at a cost of \$1.00 each.
- Residents may also order permanent window decal stickers at no charge. These permits are valid for a five (5) year period.
- Each residence shall have a specific and unique identification number that will correspond to any and all permits issued to that residence.
- Permits are not transferable and may not be given or sold to any other individual.
- The following vehicles shall be exempt from the permit parking requirements while used in the performance of their official duties:
  1. City, county, state, federal government vehicles
  2. Emergency vehicles
  3. Public / private ambulances
  4. Utility company vehicles (gas, electrical, telephone, internet, CATV)
  5. Federal and private mail and package delivery vehicles
  6. Any private commercial business vehicle performing a service (landscaping, construction, pest control, housekeeping, etc.)
  7. Vehicles displaying a valid California disabled person placard or plate.

F. PROGRAM EVALUATION:

This program will be reevaluated after 1 year to determine if modifications need to be made.
