RESOLUTION NO. 2020-97

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKLIN REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF PLACER TO CONSOLIDATE A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION WITH THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 3, 2020

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Rocklin called a general municipal election to be held on November 3, 2020, for the purpose of the election of three (3) members of the City Council whose terms expired:

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the general municipal election be consolidated with the general election to be held on the same date, and that within the City, the precincts, polling places and election officers of the two elections be the same, and that the County Election Department of the County of Placer canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election, and that the election be held in all respects as if there were only one election.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Rocklin does resolve as follows:

- <u>Section 1</u>. Pursuant to the requirements of §10403 of the Elections Code, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Placer is hereby requested to consent and agree to the consolidation of a General Municipal Election with the General Election on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, for the purpose of the election of three (3) members of the City Council;
- <u>Section 2</u>. Said members of the City Council are elected at large. There are no electoral divisions in the City; all voters within the City vote for all candidates.
- Section 3. If by the close of candidate filing, the number of qualified candidates does not exceed the number of seats to be filled in a particular office, the City Council shall, in accordance with Elections Code Section 10229(a) either 1) appoint to the office the person(s) who has been nominated and/or appoint to the office any eligible elector if no one has been nominated; or 2) hold the election, if either no one, or only one person has been nominated.
- <u>Section 4</u>. Notwithstanding the section above, Section 5 shall not apply if the number of nominees for another City office exceeds the number of seats to be filled. If this occurs, all City offices will be put before the voters of the City, regardless of the number of nominees, in accordance with Elections Code Section 10229(b).

Section 5. City has determined the following election particulars:

- The length of the Candidate Statement shall not exceed 200 words;
- The cost of the Candidate Statement shall be paid by the Candidate; and
- In the case of a tie vote, the election shall be determined by lot.

<u>Section 6</u>. There have been no changes to the City boundary lines since the last election.

<u>Section 7</u>. The County Election Department is authorized to canvass the returns of the general municipal election. The election shall be held in all respects as if there were only one election, and only one form of ballot shall be used.

<u>Section 8</u>. The Board of Supervisors is requested to issue instructions to the County Election Department to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of the consolidated election.

<u>Section 9</u>. The City of Rocklin recognizes that additional costs will be incurred by the County by reason of this consolidation and agrees to reimburse the County for any costs.

<u>Section 10</u>. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Board of Supervisors and the County Election Department of the County of Placer.
