NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKLIN WILL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS AT THE ROCKLIN CITY HALL LOCATED AT 3970 ROCKLIN ROAD, ROCKLIN, 95677 BEGINNING AT 6:00 P.M. ON TUESDAY, OCTOBER 11, 2022, TO CONSIDER THE FOLLOWING:

RE: PUBLIC HEARING ON THIRD AMENDMENT TO 2020 CDBG ANNUAL ACTION PLAN

The City of Rocklin is soliciting input on the third amendment of its 2020 Annual Action Plan, which identifies the specific activities the City will undertake during the Program Year with the use of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds. The amendment is to allow allocation and re-allocation of remaining CDBG CV-1 and CDBG-CV-3 CARES Act funds.

The City, due to the 2020 Coronavirus pandemic, is utilizing available waivers (waiver #9, Consolidated Plan Requirements) per HUD guidance contained in the memo *"Availability of Waivers of Community Planning and Development (CPD) Grant Program and Consolidated Plan Requirements to Prevent the Spread of COVID-19 and Mitigate Economic Impacts Caused by COVID-19."*

The amendment document is available for a 7-day public review starting Friday, September 2, 2022. Comments must be received by 5:00 pm on Friday, September 9, 2022.

The Public Review Draft 3rd Amendment to the 2020 CDBG Annual Action Plan can be accessed during normal business hours at City Hall (3970 Rocklin Road, Rocklin CA 95677, first floor front counter M-F 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.) and on the City's website www.rocklin.ca.us/community-development-block-grant.

Those wishing to make a public comment in person, although not required, speakers are requested to complete a speaker card and present it to the City Clerk.

Court challenges to any public hearing items may be limited to only those issues which are raised at the public hearing described in the notice or in written correspondence delivered to the City at or prior to the public hearing. (Government Code §65009) The City of Rocklin and the State of California does not discriminate in housing or employment on the basis of race, religion, sex, age, national origin, or handicap. The location of the public meeting is fully accessible to mobility impaired individuals.
