City of Rocklin CDBG Program Notice of Annual Planning and Request for Public Comment

The City of Rocklin is currently planning for the use of fiscal year 2020-21 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program funds. The City of Rocklin is also preparing its 2020 – 2024 Consolidated Plan. The Consolidated Plan, which has a duration of 5 years, describes the jurisdiction's community development priorities and multiyear goals based on an assessment of housing and community development needs, an analysis of housing and economic market conditions and available resources. CDBG funds are made available to the City as an entitlement authorized by the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974. The City has yet to be notified of its 2020-21 award. The City expects to receive an amount roughly equal to the 2019-20 award of \$282,687. The City of Rocklin is required to submit an annual Action Plan to the federal Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The Action Plan provides information on the needs of low- and moderate-income residents and eligible target areas of the City during the period between July 1, 2020 and June 30, 2021. The Plan also describes the activities that the City will undertake to meet those needs with the limited funding. Should the actual award amount differ from the current estimate, the City will make proportional adjustments to all areas of allocation.

By this Notice the City is publishing the planning calendar for 2020-21 CDBG funds and providing the public with notice of opportunities for comment on the use of CDBG funds.

On February 14, 2020 the City published a Draft 2020-21 Action Plan and its Draft 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan.

The City will accept public comment on the Draft 2020-21 Action Plan and Draft 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan until 5:00 p.m. March 16, 2020. The draft Plan is available during normal business hours at City Hall at 3970 Rocklin Road, on the City's website www.rocklin.ca.us, and at the Rocklin public library at 4890 Granite Drive.

The City Council is scheduled to hold a Public Hearing during its regularly scheduled meeting on April 14, 2020 beginning at 6:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers (3970 Rocklin Road) to consider and adopt the Annual Action Plan and the Consolidated Plan.

The City will submit the Action Plan and the Consolidated Plan to HUD for review and approval on or before May 15, 2020.
