Project Description:

In accordance with a requirement of the federally-funded Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program, city staff has prepared the annual CAPER. The CAPER contains information on performance and program accomplishments during the 2021-2022 CDBG program year. The report provides information regarding the City's expenditure of federal CDBG funds; specifically addressing progress made by the City towards completion of public service activities and accessibility projects. The 2021 CAPER has been completed in compliance with federal program regulations and the City's Citizen Participation Plan. The current CAPER covers the period from July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022 and is available for review and comment.

Public Review and Comment:

The public review period for this document will begin on **July 30, 2022**. The City of Rocklin must receive all written comments regarding the 2021 CAPER no later than 5:00 pm on **Tuesday, August 16, 2022** in order to include it before the CAPER submittal deadline. Court challenges to any public hearing items may be limited to only those issues which are raised at the public hearing described in the notice or in written correspondence delivered to the City at or prior to the public hearing.
