City of Rocklin CDBG Program Notice of Annual Planning and Request for Public Comment

The City of Rocklin is currently planning for the use of fiscal year 2026-2027 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program funds. CDBG funds are made available to the City as an entitlement authorized by the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974. The City has yet to be notified of its actual 2026-2027 award. The City expects to receive approximately \$295,000 based on prior years funding. The City of Rocklin is required to submit an Annual Action Plan to the federal Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The Action Plan provides information on the needs of low- and moderate-income residents and eligible target areas of the City during the period between July 1, 2026 and June 30, 2027. The Plan also describes the activities that the City will undertake to meet those needs with the limited funding. Should the actual award amount differ from the current estimate, the City will make proportional adjustments to all areas of allocation.

By this Notice, the City is publishing the planning calendar for 2026-2027 CDBG funds and providing the public with notice of opportunities for comment on the use of CDBG funds.

On January 23, 2026, the City published a Draft 2026-2027 Action Plan. The City will accept public comment on the draft Action Plan until 4:00 p.m. on February 23, 2026. The draft Plan is available during business hours at City Hall at 3970 Rocklin Road, at the Rocklin Public Library at 4890 Granite Drive, and on the City's website <https://www.rocklin.ca.us/cdbg>.

The City Council is scheduled to hold a Public Hearing during its regularly scheduled meeting on March 24, 2026 beginning at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers at Rocklin City Hall located at 3970 Rocklin Road, Rocklin, 95677 to solicit public comments on the draft Annual Action Plan.

The City Council is also scheduled to hold a Public Hearing during its regularly scheduled meeting on April 28, 2026 beginning at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers at Rocklin City Hall located at 3970 Rocklin Road, Rocklin, 95677 to consider the adoption of the final Annual Action Plan.

The City will submit the Action Plan to HUD for review and approval on or before May 15, 2026.

Those wishing to make a public comment in person, although not required, speakers are requested to complete a speaker card and present to the City Clerk.

Court challenges to any public hearing items may be limited to only those issues which are raised at the public hearing described in the notice or in written correspondence delivered to the City at or prior to the public hearing. (Government Code §65009) The City of Rocklin and the State of California does not discriminate in housing or employment on the basis of race, religion, sex, age, national origin, or handicap. The location of the public meeting is fully accessible to mobility impaired individuals.
