ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENT ZOA2023-0004**

This ordinance is to modify regulations addressing Temporary Signs During an Election Period and Temporary Community Signs in all areas of the City of Rocklin to establish and / or clarify design criteria, posting requirements, and display timing. Additionally, and applicable only to Temporary Signs During an Election Period, the ordinance would establish a deposit to post these signs, a fee for the removal of signs not posted in accordance with the code, and cost recovery for signs that damage public property.

The proposed amendment to the Rocklin Municipal Code is not subject to review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15060, subdivision (c)(2) (the activity will not result in a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment) and 15061, subdivision (b)(3) (there is no possibility the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment).

The proposed Amendment to the Rocklin Municipal Code was initiated by the City of Rocklin and would be effective City-wide.
