### **RE: PUBLIC HEARING ON SECOND AMENDMENT TO 2020-2021 CDBG ANNUAL ACTION PLAN**

The City is soliciting input on the second amendment of its 2020-2021 Annual Action Plan, which identifies the specific activities the City will undertake during the Program Year with the use of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds. The amendment is to allow allocation of CDBG CV-3 CARES Act funds.

The City, due to the 2020 Coronavirus pandemic, is utilizing available waivers (waiver #9, Consolidated Plan Requirements) per HUD guidance contained in the memo *"Availability of Waivers of Community Planning and Development (CPD) Grant Program and Consolidated Plan Requirements to Prevent the Spread of COVID-19 and Mitigate Economic Impacts Caused by COVID-19."*

The amendment will be available for a minimum 5-day public review starting **Friday, July 2, 2021**. Comments must be received by 5:00 pm on **Friday, July 9, 2021**. The Plan is available during normal business hours at the City's Administration Building and on the City's website [www.rocklin.ca.us/community-development-block-grant](http://www.rocklin.ca.us/community-development-block-grant).

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Any person interested in this item may contact the Housing Staff prior to the meeting date, during regular business hours, Monday through Friday between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., or by phoning (916) 625-5592 for further information. Agenda information including staff reports, resolutions, and exhibits are typically available the Wednesday prior to the public hearing date on the City website (<http://www.rocklin.ca.us/agendas-and-minutes>).

This meeting may be conducted utilizing teleconferencing and electronic means consistent with State of California Executive Order N-29-20 dated March 17, 2020 and Executive Order N 8-21 dated 6/11/21, in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. The public is welcome to attend in person or participate virtually.

For those that do not plan on attending in person, but wish to make a public comment during the meeting, public comments will be accepted in email form up until 3:00 p.m. on the meeting day.

Those wishing to make a public comment in person, although not required, speakers are requested to complete a speaker card and present to the City Clerk.

This meeting will also be offered via Zoom Webinar and the public is welcome to make a public comment through Zoom (see full instructions on the Agenda for the meeting).

Court challenges to any public hearing items may be limited to only those issues which are raised at the public hearing described in the notice or in written correspondence delivered to the City at or prior to the public hearing. (Government Code §65009) The City of Rocklin and the State of California does not discriminate in housing or employment on the
