

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCKLIN
ON PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT IMPACT FEE CHANGES

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Rocklin City Council will hold a public hearing on TUESDAY, DECEMBER 14, 2021, at the hour of 6:00 P.M., in the Council Chambers located at 3970 Rocklin Road, Rocklin, California, being the meeting place of said City Council.

The public hearing is for proposed development impact fee increases for park improvements, and public facilities, and establishing trail impact, and community and recreation facilities impact fees. At the same date and time, the City will also consider introducing an ordinance amending the Rocklin Municipal Code Chapter 3.16 pertaining to Construction Taxes and Development Impact Fees. The data supporting the proposed development impact fees and the increase in proposed development impact fees will be available for review in the City Clerk's Office and on the City's website at least ten day prior to the public hearing.

At the time and place noted above, all persons interested in the above matters may appear and be heard. Interested persons may submit written comments addressed to the City Clerk, 3970 Rocklin Road, Rocklin, California 95677, prior to the hour of 3:00 p.m. on Tuesday, DECEMBER 14, 2021.

Court challenges to any public hearing items may be limited to only those issues which are raised at the public hearing described in this notice or in written correspondence delivered to the City Clerk at or prior to the public hearing.

The location of the public meeting is fully accessible to mobility impaired individuals.
