ACCESSORY DWELLING UNITS (ADU's)

Accessory dwelling units are becoming more popular as an option to accommodate multigenerational living and / or provide lower cost rental units in urban and suburban settings. However, there are some notable costs associated with the development of these units. Anyone considering construction of an accessory dwelling unit should be aware that accessory dwelling units are required to obtain building permits and pay fees for their proportional impacts to various City facilities such as parks, streets, drainage, etc. These fees may vary somewhat depending upon the size of the accessory dwelling unit and where in the City it is located. Fees are updated from time to time, however as an example in August 2019 the City building permit and impact fees applicable to a fairly typical 768 square foot Accessory Dwelling Unit came to a total of \$12,424.24. In addition there may be fees payable to the applicable School District, Sewer District, and Water Agency that must be paid prior to issuance of a building permit.

HOW ARE IMPACT FEES CHARGES ON ACCESSORY DWELLING UNITS?

All impact fees must be charged in accordance with the Fee Mitigation Act, which requires fees to be proportional to the actual impact.
