

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED FEE INCREASES

The City Council of the City of Rocklin will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, April 23, 2019, at the Rocklin Council Chambers, 3970 Rocklin Road, Rocklin, beginning at 6:00 p.m. to consider a garbage collection service rate increase as proposed by Recology Auburn Placer, the City of Rocklin's franchised solid waste hauler. The proposed rate changes reflect a 3.2% increase in the hauler's cost of living expenses, resulting in an actual increase for the total residential monthly garbage rate of 1.89%. A rate increase comparison report will be available at the office of the City Clerk, 3970 Rocklin Road, and on the City website at www.rocklin.ca.us.

The rate increase changes for selected residential services are as follows:

The rate increase for selected commercial services are as follows (collected 1 time per week):

1x1 Cubic Yard	\$ 92.70	\$ 94.87	\$2.17	2.34%
1x4 Cubic Yard	\$300.84	\$307.28	\$6.44	2.14%
1x20 Cubic Yard	\$351.89	\$361.62	\$9.73	2.77%

Owners of property and customers served by Recology Auburn Placer may protest the proposed increase in fees by addressing the City Council at the public hearing or filing a written protest with the City Clerk at the above address. The written protest must identify the parcel served by address or Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) and be actually received (not postmarked) by the City Clerk, before or during the public hearing. Only one protest per parcel shall be counted for purposes of establishing a majority protest to the proposed fee increase.
