COMMUNITY RIDE-ALONG/SIT-ALONG PROGRAM

Attached, please find an application for the Rocklin Police Department Community Ride-Along/Sit-Along Program. The goals of this program are to educate, inform, and provide opportunities for Rocklin residents to observe police patrol operations and/or emergency communications activities to facilitate an understanding of public safety processes and enhance community-police partnerships.

Rocklin residents aged *16 or older may apply to participate in the ride-along/sit-along program. Each applicant must sign the attached waiver and release form indicating he/she is aware of and assumes all risk of danger or injury and further waives any claim against the City of Rocklin, the Chief of Police, or other city personnel. Approved applicants may participate once every twelve months. *(Applicants under 18 years of age must have the approval and signature of a parent or guardian).

The attached form may be dropped off or mailed to 4080 Rocklin Road, Rocklin, CA 95677 or faxed to (916) 625-5495. A criminal background check will be completed on all applicants, and notification of the status of the application will be made within fourteen days of the date the application was received. Following application approval, the applicant will be notified of a scheduled ride-along date and time.

Ride-alongs and sit-alongs are scheduled in a maximum of four-hour increments for a day, swing or graveyard-shift. During business hours, participants should report to the front counter of the police department and notify Records personnel that they are scheduled for a ride or sit-along. After business hours, the participant should pick up the phone outside the main lobby doors of the police department to notify Communications that he/she is scheduled for a ride-along or sit-along. A police employee will meet the participant in the lobby of the police department.

*Parents/guardians of any applicant between the ages of 16 and 18 must fill out and sign the application and release/waiver. Applications for under-age participants will be reviewed and approved/denied on a case-by-case basis.

RIDE-ALONG/SIT-ALONG REGULATIONS

The purpose of the Community Ride-Along/Sit-Along Program is to encourage rapport between community members and their police department, as well as to provide community members an understanding of police operations. Participation in the ride-along program is a privilege, and is subject to the following regulations:

- Eligible applicants must reside, work, or attend school in the City of Rocklin, or receive specific permission from the watch commander to participate.
- Eligible applicants must be sixteen (16) years of age or older. (Parents/guardians of those under 18 years will be required to fill out and sign the application and release/waiver form).
- No person shall be allowed to ride or sit along without having submitted a signed ride-along/sit-along application and waiver form.
- Applicants will be allowed to participate once every twelve months.
- An applicant that fails to keep his/her ride/sit-along appointment without making prior rescheduling arrangements will not be eligible to participate in the program for six months from the date of the originally-schedule ride/sit-along.
- Participants must follow all lawful instructions provided by the police employee to whom he/she is assigned.
- Participants must not exit a patrol vehicle unless instructed to do so by an authorized police employee.
- During a ride-along, the participant may be dropped off at a safe location if circumstances dictate it is not prudent for the participant to respond to a potentially dangerous situation. If this were to occur, another officer not assigned to that incident would be instructed to retrieve the participant as quickly as possible.
- The participant will provide his/her own transportation to and from the police department.
- Background checks will be conducted on all applicants. The Rocklin Police Department reserves the right to disqualify an
 applicant from participation in this program. Below are examples of potentially disqualifying background findings;
 - o Criminal history
 - o Negative contacts with the participant in the past
 - Suspect, mentioned, or victim in an ongoing criminal investigation
- Tours are scheduled in four-hour increments; however, either the police employee or the participant may terminate the tour at
 any time following notification of the watch commander.
- Applicants will be contacted within two weeks of application with a confirmation or denial.
- Participants shall not participate in any police activity unless directly requested by a police employee. During a ride-along, the participant shall not converse with any prisoners, suspects, victims, or witnesses.
- All participants must agree to hold all matters pertaining to the names of suspects, victims, or witnesses; issues relating to evidence gathered in the course of an investigation; or victim and witness statements as **confidential**.
- Recording devices and cameras will not be permitted while participating in the program, unless express permission is granted by the watch commander.
- Participants must be presentably attired in business casual attire (slacks, collared shirt, and closed-toed shoes). Jeans, T-shirts, or open-toed shoes are not allowed and will result in the cancellation of the ride or sit-along.

By signing the attached waiver form, the participant agrees to the rules and regulations listed above.

That the City of Rocklin, Chief of Police, and all members of the Rocklin Police Department shall not be responsible or liable for any injury, damage, loss, or expense, either to me or no property, incurred while riding in any vehicle assigned to the police department or while accompanying any member or members of said department during the performance of their official duties and resulting from any negligent act or omission on the part of any member of the Rockle Police Department.
