



Notice of Standard CDBG Funds Available for PY22

SUBMITTALS DUE: NO LATER THAN 4:00 P.M. DECEMBER 15, 2021

The City of Rocklin anticipates receiving an estimated allocation of \$284,000 in Standard Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds for the 2022 Program Year (PY). Staff is beginning the process of identifying various activities that will be undertaken with 2022 Standard CDBG funds. These CDBG funds can be used for a wide variety of community development activities which provide direct benefit to low and moderate income *Rocklin* residents, aid in the prevention of slum and blight, or fulfill an urgent need.

Types of **eligible activities** can include:

- * Acquisition of Real Property
- * Housing Rehabilitation
- * Down Payment and other homeownership assistance
- * Public Facilities and Improvements
- * Economic Development
- * Public Services
- * Removal of Architectural Barriers
- * Commercial and Residential Property Rehabilitation
- * Social services such as job training, transportation, health care, and child care *
- * Planning Activities **
- * Program Administration **

* Social service activities are limited to no more than 15% of the annual grant (\$42,600)

** Planning and Administration costs are limited to no more than 20% of the annual grant (\$56,800)

In preparing comments or proposing activities, please keep in mind CDBG funds **must** meet a **National Objective and** qualify as an **Eligible Activity**:

- * Benefit to Low and Moderate Income Persons
- * Aid in the Prevention of Slums and Blight
- * Urgent Need

Ineligible Activities:

Generally, the following types of activities are ineligible:

- Acquisition, construction, or reconstruction of buildings for the general conduct of government;
- Political activities;

- Certain income payments; and
- Construction of new housing by units of general local government.

While HUD does not provide CDBG assistance directly to individuals, businesses, nonprofit organizations, or other non-governmental entities; contractors may be selected by the City of Rocklin through a competitive recruitment process which gives priority to those who are able to best meet the needs of the community in accordance with the national objectives and other requirements of the CDBG program.
