NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY FOR THE ROCKLIN ROAD AND INTERSTATE 80 INTERCHANGE PROJECT INITIAL STUDY WITH PROPOSED MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

What's being planned?

The City of Rocklin has prepared an Initial Study with proposed Mitigated Negatived Declaration (IS/MND) for the Rocklin Road and Interstate 80 (I-80) Interchange Project in Placer County, California. The City of Rocklin, in cooperation with California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), proposes to modify the Rocklin Road/I-80 Interchange from the existing standard diamond-type interchange to a diverging diamond interchange configuration and create a dedicated crossing for pedestrians and bicyclists.

Why this notice?

The City of Rocklin, as the lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) has prepared an IS/MND to analyze the potential environmental effects of the proposed project. This notice is to inform you of the public comment period.
