

## CITY OF ROCKLIN COMMERCIAL SIGN STANDARDS SUMMARY FOR TEMPORARY SIGNS\*

Types of Signs Permitted	Commercial and non-commercial building, freestanding signs, portable signs.
Max. No. of Signs Allowed	One freestanding sign per street frontage for the complex. One freestanding sign for each tenant building frontage. One building sign for each tenant building frontage. In lieu of a building sign, special advertising devices such as balloons and pennants may be displayed provided the display period does not exceed 14 days. One portable sign for new businesses.
Maximum Area	<ul><li>16 square feet for each freestanding sign excluding the allowed signage of portable signs.</li><li>32 square feet for each building sign.</li><li>12 square feet for portable signs</li></ul>
Height Limits	Eight (8) feet for freestanding signs. Four (4) feet for portable signs.
Setback	Freestanding signs shall be set back a minimum of three (3) feet from any property line adjacent to a street or the street right-of-way.
Time Limit	Maximum of 90 days in a calendar year. These 90 days can be used at the discretion of the applicant and do not have to be consecutive.

\*Summary for signs on developed properties in Business Professional, Commercial & Industrial zones. See Sign Ordinance chapter 17.75.060D for vacant properties.

- Freestanding signs over 6 feet must be 100 feet or more from any other freestanding sign.
- All temporary signs require an over-the-counter sign permit.
