

NOTICE OF ELECTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a General Municipal Election will be held in the City of Rocklin on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, for the following offices:

City Council Member	Full Term of Four (4) Years
City Council Member	Full Term of Four (4) Years

The nomination period for these offices begins on July 13, 2026 and closes on August 7, 2026 at 5:00 p.m.

If nomination papers for an incumbent officer of the City are not filed by August 7, 2026 the voters shall have until the 83rd day before the election, August 12, 2026, to nominate candidates other than the person(s) who are the incumbents on the 88th day before the election, for that incumbent's elective office.

Nomination information can be obtained in the Office of the City Clerk, 3970 Rocklin Road, Rocklin, California between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

If no one or only one person is nominated for an elective office, appointment to the elective office may be made as prescribed by California Elections Code Section 10299.

Vote centers will be open between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. on November 3, 2026 Election Day.

NOTICE OF MEASURE TO BE VOTED ON

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that a measure to be voted on, Measure C – General Transactions and Use Tax (Sales Tax) will be submitted to the voters of the City of Rocklin at the General Municipal Election to be held on November 3, 2026, as follows:

Ballot Question

To maintain Rocklin's public safety, financial stability and core public services, including: rapid 911 emergency/ medical response; police/ fire protection; keeping public areas and parks healthy/ safe/ clean; preserving open space; preventing wildfires; shall the City of Rocklin's measure establishing a half-cent sales tax, providing approximately \$8 million annually for general revenue purposes, until ended by voters, keeping all funds local, with annual audits/ public spending disclosure, be adopted?

SYNOPSIS OF THE MEASURE

Measure C provides voters an opportunity to consider raising a half cent sales tax to provide revenue for general purposes to maintain services in the City including but not limited to public safety and financial stability, maintaining core public services, rapid 911 emergency/medical response, police/fire protection, keeping public areas and parks healthy/safe/clean, preserving open space, and preventing wildfires. The language also highlights that if approved by voters, all funds from the tax be kept local with annual audits / public spending disclosure.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN by the City Clerk, pursuant to Article 4, Chapter 3, Division 9, Sections 9280 through 9287 of the Elections Code of the State of California, that the following deadlines are hereby established as the final dates on which arguments and rebuttal arguments for and against the measure appearing on the ballot for the General Municipal Election to be held on November 3, 2026, may be submitted to the City Clerk for printing and distribution to the voters as required by law:

Deadline for Filing Primary Arguments: 5:00 p.m., Friday, August 7, 2026

Deadline for Filing Rebuttal Arguments: 5:00 p.m., Monday, August 17, 2026

Primary Arguments, not to exceed 300 words in length, and Rebuttal Arguments, not to exceed 250 words in length, are to be submitted to the City Clerk, 3970 Rocklin Road, Rocklin, CA on or before the deadlines. Submitted arguments are kept confidential until after the filing deadline. Arguments cannot be changed after the deadline.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that there shall be set a ten-calendar day examination period for public review of said Arguments. During this time, any registered voter of the election jurisdiction, or the elections official, may seek a writ of mandate or an injunction requiring any or all of the materials to be amended or deleted. The review period for Arguments is as follows: Primary Arguments commence August 8, 2026 and end August 17, 2026; Rebuttal Arguments commence August 18, 2026 and end August 27, 2026.
